OPINION AND ORDER

This is an application filed by Cecil J. Allen pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 6 of the Commission's General Order No. 101 for approval of certificates of insurance issued by Cravens, Dargan & Company providing insurance coverage with Lloyd's of London.

Under authority granted by Decision No. 46973, dated April 8, 1952, applicant acquired a passenger stage operative right between San Rafael, San Quentin and Point San Quentin and between San Rafael and Bret Harte Village. It appears that he is engaged in operating a 7-passenger limousine and that in order to meet his obligations for personal liability and property damage he has obtained certificates of insurance issued by Cravens, Dargan & Company providing for coverage with Lloyd's of London in the amounts of \$25,000 and \$50,000 for bodily injury liability, and in the amount of \$10,000 for property damage liability.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary, that the amounts of insurance coverage on applicant's equipment as reported meet the requirements of General Order No. 101, and that an order should

be entered approving the certificates of insurance; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The Commission hereby approves said certificates of insurance, and the endorsements, issued by Cravens, Dargan & Company providing for insurance coverage for Cecil J. Allen with Lloyd's of London, and a renewal, or renewals, of said certificates.

2. This order is effective upon the date hereof.
