OPINION AND ORDER

This is an application filed pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 6 of the Commission's General Order No. 101 for approval of a certificate of insurance issued by Watson Surplus Lines Agency, Inc. providing insurance coverage for Beninger Transportation Service, Inc. by Lloyd's of London.

Applicant is engaged in business as a carrier of passengers by motor coach generally between Richmond, East Richmond Heights and El Sobrante, operating two 30-passenger buses.<sup>(1)</sup> To meet its obligations for personal liability and property damage, it has obtained from Watson Surplus Lines Agency, Inc. a certificate of insurance, a copy of which has been filed with the Commission, providing for insurance coverage with Lloyd's in the amounts of \$25,000 and \$80,000 for bodily injuries and in the amount of \$10,000 for property damage.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The Commission hereby approves the certificate of insurance, and the endorsements, issued by Watson Surplus Lines Agency, Inc. providing for insurance coverage for Beninger Transportation Service, Inc. by Lloyd's of London, and a renewal, or renewals, of said certificate.

2. This order is effective upon the date hereof.
