The Western Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than forty feet and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G.O. No. 75-B). Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time - 1 -
