O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct an additional spur track at grade across the intersection of Twenty-fourth Street and Harrison Avenue in National City, San Diego County, at the location described in the application. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

It is alleged that Twenty-fourth Street and Harrison Avenue are not at present open to public use and travel, and this order is not to be deemed authority for such opening.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience,

necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
