SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 47473, dated July 15, 1952, on Application No. 33372, Pasadena City Lines was given authority to route its Linda Vista Route No. 6 via a route terminating at Colorado Street and Marengo Avenue in the City of Pasadena.

By letter dated August 6, 1952, Pasadena City Lines has advised the Commission that in accordance with the authority granted by Decision No. 40264, dated May 13, 1947, on Application No. 27841, Linda Vista Route No. 6 was combined with a portion of the Pasadena City Lines' Avenue 64 Line No. 7 so that Route No. 6, instead of terminating at Garfield Avenue and Colorado Street, extends from that intersection, east on Colorado Street to Los Robles Avenue, south on Los Robles Avenue to Glenarm Street, and thence via Glenarm Street, Marengo Avenue, Ohio Street, Euclid Avenue and Alpine Street to Los Robles Avenue.

In order to permit Pasadena City Lines to operate its Route No. 6 over the route presently traversed,

IT IS ORDERED that the route description of Pasadena City Lines' Linda Vista Route No. 6 contained in ordering paragraph 2 on pages 5 and 6 of Decision No. 47473 is amended to read as follows:

Commencing at Foothill Boulevard and Commonwealth Avenue, in the County of Los Angeles, thence via Foothill Boulevard, LaCanada-Verdugo Road, Alminar Avenue, Baptiste Way, Viro Road, Michigan Avenue, Oak Grove Drive, La Canada-Verdugo Road, Linda Vista Avenue, Seco Street, Rosemont Avenue, Orange Grove Avenue, Colorado Street, Los Robles Avenue, Glenarm Street, Marengo Avenue, Ohio Street, Euclid Avenue, Alpine Street to Los Robles Avenue in the City of Pasadena.

Except as herein amended, Decision No. 47473, dated July 15, 1952, on Application No. 33372, shall remain in full force and effect.
