ORDER OF REVOCATION

Alameda Transportation Company, Inc., a corporation, was authorized to operate the motorship "Neptune" as a common carrier of property between San Francisco on the one hand and all points on the Oakland Estuary on the other hand; also between San Francisco, Oakland and Alameda on the one hand and Yerba Buena Island and Yerba Buena Shoals on the other hand.¹ It appears that all operations ceased in August, 1951, and will not be resumed because the vessel used has become unseaworthy and the principal officer and owner of the corporation has withdrawn from business activities due to ill health. It appears, further, that Alameda Transportation Company, Inc., did not seek nor secure authorization to suspend or discontinue its common carrier vessel operations; therefore, it is found that Alameda Transportation Company, Inc., is no longer conducting and has abandoned said operations.

IT IS ORDERED that the operative rights Alameda Transportation Company, Inc., was found to possess by Decision No. 29778 in Case No. 4012 and the rights granted by Decision No. 29876 in Application No. 20973 are hereby revoked and all effective

tariffs and timetables on file in the name of Alameda Transportation Company, Inc., are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Alameda Transportation Company, Inc.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after service of a copy hereof upon Alameda Transportation Company, Inc., unless said Alameda Transportation Company, Inc., before such effective date shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order, denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will be stayed until hearing is had and further order issued.
