O P I N I O N

Southern Pacific Company in the above numbered First Supplemental Application requests the Commission to modify Decision No. 47238 dated June 5, 1952 by eliminating the condition requiring two reflectorized "3 Track" signs at the crossing authorized therein.

It appears that the track arrangement shown on Southern Pacific Company Drawing No. San Joaquin Division A6512, revised 2-13-50, attached to Application No. 33358 is such that the users of County Road No. 3E at Radnor, County of Tulare, (Crossing No. B-277.1) should be informed of the number of tracks comprising the grade crossing. Further it appears that sufficient cause has not been shown to justify modification of said Decision No. 47238.

O R D E R

Therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that First Supplemental Application No. 33358 be and the same is dismissed without prejudice.
