## OPINION

Applicants, Evelyn M. Knapp and John P. Demeter doing business as Peninsula Transit Lines, presently rendering a passenger stage service between Palo Alto, North Palo Alto, San Carlos, Redwood City, Atherton, Menlo Park, Woodside and Toyon Knolls, request authority to extend Routes Nos. 2, 5 and 7.

The authority to operate was granted by Decision No. 42934 dated June 1, 1949, in Application No. 30172. Route No. 2 was subsequently amended by Decision No. 46008 dated July 31, 1951, in Application No. 32562.

The proposed extensions, according to applicants, would not increase fares nor require any additional equipment.

In justification for the authority sought, applicants allege that the proposed areas to be served are contiguous to the City of Palo Alto and have experienced an increased growth in population as the result of newly constructed homes; that at the present time there are no means of public transportation service of the residents along said proposed extended routes and for the residents residing immediately adjacent thereto; and that the elimination of the loop area at the end of the present Route No. 7

(3) That in all other respects Decision No. 42934 shall remain in full force and effect.
