## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 47663 of September 2, 1952, in Case No. 4808, the Commission found that the minimum rates, rules and regulations set forth in City Carriers ' Tariff No. 3-A - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 4-A (used household goods) were not designed for application to the operations of independent-contractor subhaulers in rendering service for other carriers. It concluded that the tariff provisions should specifically be made inapplicable to such operations. The tariff will be amended accordingly.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that City Carriers' Tariff No. 3-A -Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 4-A (Appendix "A" to Decision No. 44919 as amended) be and it is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, Third Revised Page 4 cancels Second Revised Page 4 and Second Revised Page 5 cancels First Revised Page 5, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

DEFINITION OF TECHNICAL TERMS (Concluded) (1) FOINT OF ORIGIN means the precise location at which property is physically delivered by the consignor or his agent that the custody of the carrier for transportation, except that (1) all locations within a radius of 50 feet from a single point, and (2) all locations within a radius of 300 feet on a single piece of property of a single consignor will be considered as one point of origin. (n) RATE includes charge and, also, the ratings, mini- mum weight, rules and regulations governing, and the acces- sorial charges applying in connection therewith. (n) SAME TRANSPORTATION means transportation of the same kind and quantity of property between the same points, and subject to the same limitations, conditions and privi- leges, although not necessarily in an identical type of equip- ment. (c) SHIPMENT means a quantity of property tendered for transportation to one carrier at one time on one shipping document by: (1) One shipper at one point of origin for one consignee at one point of destination; or (2) One shipper at one point of origin for one consignee at more than one point of origin, or more than one shipper at one or more points of origin, for one consignee at one points of origin for one consignee at one point of destination (split pickup); or (3) One shipper at oner than one point of desti- nation, or for more than one point between point of origin and point of destination for a period not in excess of 30 days. (r) TERKITORY means one of the territories described in Section No. 2. (s) UNCRATED PROPERTY means property not packed in accordance with the crated property requirements set forth in pargraph (d). (t) UNIT OF EQUIPMENT means one or more motor vehi- cles physically connected so as to form a complete unit. (u) UNPACKING means any accessorial service per- formed in connection with deli	

## APPLICATION OF TARIFF - CARATERS

Rates provided in this tariff are minimum rates, established pursuant to the City Carriers' Act, the Highway Carriers' Act, and the Household Goods Carriers Act. They apply for the transportation of commodities described in Item No. 40 series, by carriers as defined in Item No. 10 series. \*Rates, rules and regulations named in this tariff shall not apply to transportation by independent-contractor subhaulers when such transportation is performed for other carriers. This exception shall not be construed to exempt from the tariff provisions carriers for whom the independent contractors are performing transportation service.
