O P I N I O N

The petitioners Motor Truck Association of Southern California and Truck Owners Association of California request that the effective date of Decisions Nos. 47566, dated August 11, 1947, and 47670, dated September 2, 1952, be postponed pending possible action by the Legislature of the State of California with relation to legislation affecting safety regulations for motor carriers.

The petitioners Livestock Carriers Conference of the Truck Owners Association of California and Livestock Carriers Conference of the Motor Truck Association of Southern California request that the provisions of Section 8.11 of General Order No. 99 be extended so far as livestock carriers are concerned, pending consideration of conditions allegedly peculiar to the livestock industry. This matter is now set for hearing October 8, 1952, in the Commission's courtroom at Los Angeles, but will be taken off calendar.

After consideration of these petitions, we find that the effective date of General Order No. 99 should not be extended at this time, but that the two petitions should be set for a joint hearing at a time and place to be selected.

Petitions as above entitled having been filed, the Commission being fully advised in the premises and hereby finding it to be in the public interest, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the effective date of General Order No. 99 shall not be extended at this time, but that the two petitions shall be set for hearing at a time and place to be selected.
