In the Matter of the application of THE WESTERN PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY for authority to construct a second track at grade across Chrissman Road) Application No. 33754 in the County of San Joaquin, State of California.

ORDER

The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to construct a side track at grade across Chrissman Road, near Carbona, San Joaquin County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 4-72.8. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding five per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 8 crossing signals (G. O. No. 75-B). Said side track shall be connected to said signals. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days. after the date hereof. A Dated atankedeh, California, this _ day of 1952.
