ORDER

construct a spur track at grade across lith Avenue and to relocate an existing spur track at grade across said lith Avenue and a county road near Chico, Butte County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as portions of Crossing No. 8-158.7. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue and road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadways and with grades of approach substantially as shown on Exhibit "A" attached to the application. Protection shall be by existing overhead crossing sign and by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Commissioners
