ORDER VACATING SUSPENSION AND INVESTIGATION ORDER

On August 26, 1952 tariff sheets filed by The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company under Advice Letter No. 5387, being Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. 94-T, Telephone Answering Service, together with revisions to existing Schedules Cal. P.U.C. Nos. 12-T, 17-T, 20-T, 21-T, 28-T, 32-T, 36-T, 38-T, and 95-T which relate to telephone answering service, were suspended until January 9, 1953. Prior to the hearing, respondent, desiring to cancel said sheets, made an appropriate filing cancelling the same, to become effective September 28, 1952. Therefore, cause for suspension being removed, the suspension order of August 26, 1952 is vacated and set aside and this proceeding discontinued as of the date hereof.
