#### Abstract

Applicant herein requests authority to operato as a kighway comon carrier for the transportation of proporty botwoon Yermo and Harvard Siding, via U. S. Eighway 466, sorving all intermodiato points and all orr-route points within mine (9) miles of Harvard Siding; between Barstow and Daggett, on the one hand, and the Marine Corps Field Artillery and AntiArcraft Training Contor located about $31 x$ miles northeriy of Iwemtynine Paims, on the other, via U. S. Highway 66 and unnumbered county road, serving Amboy and all points within a mine-mile radius thereof; and to extond service from colton to Riverside so as to extend applicant's pickup and deifvery


service, limiting this extonsion to trafilc moving to points genoraliy north of Vordemont. An amendment was flled to the application whoreby all intemediate points betweon Daggett and the arore-montioned Conter were ciminatod and, further, wherein it was proposed that applicant should sorve the Marine Corps Center only and not serve any area surrounding it whethor within a threo-mile Ilmit or otherwiso.

A puolic hearing was held on August 26, 1952, at San Bernardino at which tine ovidence was adduced and the mattor vas submittod.

The tostimony discioses that applicant is a Caiffornia corporation having its principal place of business at 2019 North Main Street, Los Angeles 3i, Cai1rornia. It is presentiy engaged in the transportation of property as a highway common carrier pursuant to a number of certificates of public convenience and necessity previousiy issued by this Commission.

The service to Earvard Siding and to the Marine Corps Center is proposed to be on call whereas the service to Riverside is proposed to be a daily pickup and delivery sorvice at Riverside. Appilcant does not propose to servo Twontjinine palms but, rather, to Ifmit service to the Marine Corps Conter previousiy mentioned.

The testimony disclosed that the aforementioned Center presentiy is under construction and that there will be a considerabie amount of hauing of construction material and supplies thereto, as woll as bauling to the Conter arter it 13 comploted and in operation.

As to the proposed extension to Harvard Siding,
applicant presentiy provides service to various govermment installations, hauling some of the traific fron railroad sidings. In the future some of this traific will be handied through Harrard Siding.

Concerning the proposed extension to Riverside, applicant has had numerous requests to oxtend 1ts pickup and delivery service to that ares in order to bancie the increasing amount of traific in that vicinity.

Attached to the application is a list of equipment operated by this applicant, as well as a balance sheot statoment of June 30, 2952, and a proift and loss statement for the ifrst six months ended June $30,2952$.

The rates proposed are those now published in Freight Tariff No. 18-A, California P.J.C. No. 10, of Southwestern Motor Tarini Bureau, J: L. Beeler; Agent.

Upon this record wo find that public convenience and necessity require that Victorville-Barstiow Truck inne, a california corporation, establish and operato a highway common carrier servico for the trensportation of property between the points and over the routes as set out in the ensuing order.

V1ctorvilie-Barstow Iruck Iine. Is horeby placod upon notice that oporativo rigints, as such, do not constitute a class of property which may bo capitalized or used as an eloment of value in rate-rixing, for any amount of money in excess of that originaliy paid to the state as the consfderation for the grant of such rights. Aside from their puroly permissive aspoct, they extend to the holeor a full or pertial monopoly of a clags
of business over a particular route. Inis monopoly feature may be chenged or destroyed at any time by the state, which is not, in any respect, ilmitod to tho muber of rights which may begiven.

Application as above ontitiod having boen ified, public hearing having boen held thereon, the matter having beon submitted, the Comission being fuliy advised in the premises and hereby finding that public convonience and necessity so require, IT IS ORDERED:
(1) That a certificate of pubilc convenionce and necossity authorizing oporations as a highway comon carrior as defined in Section 213 of the Public Jtilities Act, bo, ame it horeoy 1s, granted to Victorvilie-Earstow Truck Iine, a California corporation, fox the transportation of goneral commodities with the rollowing exceptions:
a. Uneratoc household goods
b. Livestock
c. Comoditien in buik
d. Articies of extraordinary value
e. Comodities injurious on contaminating to othor 2ading
-. Uncrated, unpecked, and unwrapped now furniture
8. Dangerous explosives
betweon Yermo and Eiarvard Siding, between Barstow and Daggett, on the one hand, and the Marino Corps Fiold Artiliory and Antim Alrcraft Training Center located approximatoly six miles northerly of Twentynine palms, on the other, serving no intermediate points, and between Riverside and Colton, subject to the following restriction:

Service to the Marine Corps Field Artillery

> and Anti-Alrcrart Training Center shall be lIfted to the area within the boundaries of the aforesaid center.
(2) That, in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe"the
following service regulations:
(a) Within thirty (30) days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
(b) Within sixty (60) days after tho effective date hereof, and upon not less than rite (5) days notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate and concurrently make effective, tarisiss and time schedules satisfactory to the Commission.
(c) Subject to the authority of this Commission to change or modify such at any time, Victor-ville-Barstow Truck In ne shall conduct said highway common carries service between the following points and over the following routes:

> J. S. Highway 466 between Yemmo and Harvard Siding; commencing at Barstow or Daggett, thence via J. S. Highway. 66 to Amoy, thence via an unnumbered county highway in a southerly and westerly direction to the Marine corps Center, and return over the same route; between colton and Riverside via California Highway No. 18.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20)
days after the date hereof.
