SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 46090, dated August 14, 1951, as amended by Decision No. 46821, dated March 11, 1952, the Commission authorized Hacienda Water Company to issue \$125,000 par value of common stock for the purpose of financing the cost of constructing a public utility water system in and about the Brown's Valley area adjoining the City of Napa. Applicant now reports that it has been requested by residents in an area contiguous to that now being served by it to extend its lines to serve them and that such residents have offered to purchase stock in amounts necessary to finance the cost of the extensions, which will consist of approximately 5-1/2 miles of mains. Accordingly, applicant has requested the Commission for authorization to issue and sell an additional \$35,000 of common stock for this purpose.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that a further hearing is not necessary; that the application should be granted, as herein provided; that the money, property or labor to be procured or paid for by the issue of the common stock herein authorized is reasonably required by applicant for the purpose specified herein; and that such purpose is not, in whole or in part, reasonably chargeable to operating expenses or to income; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

- l. Hacienda Water Company, after the effective date hereof and on or before December 31, 1952, may issue and sell, at par, not exceeding \$35,000 par value of common stock, in addition to the \$125,000 par value heretofore authorized, for the purpose indicated in this supplemental order.
 - 2. Applicant shall file with the Commission monthly reports as required by General Order No. 24-A, which order, insofar as applicable, is made a part of this order.
 - 3. The authority herein granted will become effective twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
