ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

It appearing by Commission Decision No. 46515, dated December 11, 1951, in the above proceeding, that Dudley Atkins was authorized to establish and operate a service as a passenger stage corporation for the transportation of passengers and baggage (1) between Los Angeles, Glendale, Pasadena and La Canada, on the one hand, and Mt. Wilson and the village at the present terminus of Angeles Crest Highway, on the other hand; and (2) between the intersection of Haskell Avenue (Angeles Crest Highway) and Olive Street (in La Canada) and Mt. Wilson and the village at present terminus of Angeles Crest Highway, and intermediate points; that no evidence of renewal of adequate protection against liability imposed by law for the payment of damages for personal injury or property damage has been filed with the Commission by said Dudley Atkins, as required by General Order No. 101; and that the passenger stage service in question was discontinued September 3, 1952, because of the inability of said Dudley Atkins to renew his insurance coverage; therefore, it is found that Dudley Atkins is no longer conducting and has discontinued said passenger stage operation.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate issued to Dudley Atkins by Decision No. 46515 in this proceeding is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file in the name of Dudley Atkins are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Dudley Atkins.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth (20th) day after service of a copy hereof upon Dudley Atkins, unless said Dudley Atkins before such effective date shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order, denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will thereby be stayed until hearing is had and further order issued.
