ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

It appearing by Commission Decision No. 43052, dated June 28, 1949, that Stuart James Lull was authorized to establish and operate a service as a passenger stage corporation for the transportation of persons between Lucerne Valley and Victorville, and intermediate points; that no evidence of adequate protection against liability imposed by law for the payment of damages for personal injury or property damage has been filed with the Commission by said Stuart James Lull, as required by General Order No. 101; and that the passenger stage service in question has been discontinued for a substantial period of time without any authorization to suspend or discontinue such operations; therefore, it is found that Stuart James Lull is no longer conducting and has abandoned said passenger stage operation.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate issued to Stuart James Lull by Decision No. 43052 in this proceeding is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file in the name of Stuart James Lull are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Stuart James Lull.
