OPINION AND ORDER

Jefferys' Mill & Warehouse Company, Inc., a corporation, conducts public utility warehouse operations at Winters. By this application authority is sought to lease the warehouse property and equipment to John Dean Vogan, an individual, doing business as Winters Warehouses. The proposed lease is for a ten-year period beginning November 1, 1952.

The verified application shows that the corporation desires to devote full time to the expanding of its grain processing business; that Vogan is experienced in the grain business and intends to devote his full time to the conduct of the warehouse operation; and that he intends to continue the public utility storage operations now conducted by the corporation. No change is proposed in the service available to the public or in the rates therefor.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted. In view of the fact that applicants desire to execute the lease by November 1, 1952, the order herein will be made effective in ten days.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Jefferys' Mill & Warehouse Company, Inc., a corporation, may, on or before December 15, 1952, lease the warehouse property and equipment involved in this proceeding to John Dean Vogan, an individual, doing business as Winters Warehouses, for a ten-year period, as requested, and execute a lease in a form substantially the same as the form of lease attached to the application; that prior to the effective date of said lease, Jefferys' Mill & Warehouse Company, Inc., and John Dean Vogan, shall, on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public, supplement or reissue tariffs on file with the Commission insofar as they name rates, rules and regulations governing the warehouse operations here involved to show that Jefferys' Mill & Warehouse Company, Inc., has withdrawn or canceled and that John Dean Vogan has concurrently adopted or established as his own said rates, rules and regulations; and that the tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall in all other respects comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of warehouse tariffs as set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 61.

The effective date of this order shall be ten (10) days after the date hereof.
