ORDER

The County of Los Angeles is authorized to widen existing crossing at grade of Rosecrans Avenue with tracks of Pacific Electric Railway Company at the intersection of Paramount Boulevard in Los Angeles County, Crossing No. 6N-12.99. Width of the crossing shall be not less than 56 feet and grades of approach not to exceed three per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by four Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B). Construction expense shall be apportioned equally between the applicant and the Pacific Electric Railway Company. Maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines together with the maintenance cost of the four Standard No. 8 flashing light signals.

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one (1) year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
