OPINION AND ORDER

This is an application filed by C. B. Green pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 6 of the Commission's General Order No. 101 for approval of a certificate of insurance issued by Watson Surplus Lines Agency, Inc. providing insurance coverage with Lloyd's of London.

Under authority granted by Decision No. 47144, dated May 13, 1952, applicant acquired operative rights for the transportation of passengers between Chico and Stirling City and Paradise and Oroville and intermediate points. It appears that he is engaged in operating a 29-passenger bus and that in order to meet his obligations for personal liability and property damage he has obtained a certificate of insurance issued by Watson Surplus Lines Agency, Inc. providing for coverage with Lloyd's of London in the amounts of \$15,000 and \$80,000 for bodily injury liability, and in the amount of \$10,000 for property damage liability.⁽¹⁾

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary, that the amounts of insurance coverage on applicant's equipment as reported meet the

requirements of General Order No. 101, and that an order should be entered approving the certificate of insurance; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The Commission hereby approves said certificate of insurance, and the endorsements, issued by Watson Surplus Lines Agency, Inc. providing for insurance coverage for C. B. Green with Lloyd's of London, and a renewal, or renewals, of said certificate.

2. This order is effective upon the date hereof.
