OPINION AND ORDER

John J. Valine & Louis Roza & John B. Roza, applicants herein, doing business as Chico Butane & Appliance Company, are engaged in operating a petroleum irregular route carrier service in the State of California. (1) In order to meet their obligations for personal liability and property damage they have obtained a certificate of insurance issued by Cravens, Dargan & Co., providing for coverage with Lloyd's of London in the amounts of \$25,000 and \$50,000 for bodily injury liability and in the amount of \$25,000 for property damage. In this application, filed pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 5 of the Commission's General Order No. 100, they seek approval of such certificate.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary, that the amounts of

(1) By Decision No. 45074, dated December 5, 1950, the Commission granted applicants a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a petroleum irregular route carrier throughout the state for the transportation of petroleum and petroleum products in tank trucks and trailers. Applicants' annual report to the Commission indicates that their service is conducted between Martinez, Richmond, Orland, Rio Vista, Grass Valley and Red Bluff. They report their transport income for the first eight months of 1952 at \$17,398 and their net income at \$6,419. For the latest year reported, their insurance premiums for bodily injury liability and property damage amounted to \$1,894.84 and claims paid to \$660. No claims now are pending.

insurance coverage provided in said certificate of insurance meet the requirements of General Order No. 100, and that an order should be entered approving said certificate; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The Commission approves the certificate of insurance issued by Cravens, Dargan & Co. providing for insurance coverage for John J. Valine & Louis Roza & John B. Roza with Lloyd's of London, and a renewal, or renewals, of said certificate.

2. This order is effective upon the date hereof.
