ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

It appearing by Commission Decision No. 44244, dated May 26, 1950; in the above proceeding, that C. J. Lockefeer was authorized to establish and operate a service as a petroleum irregular route carrier for the transportation of petroleum and petroloum products in tank trucks and tank trailers between all points and places in the State of California, that C. J. Lockefeer died March 17, 1951, that Mrs. Viola Lockefeer was appointed administratrix of the estate of C. J. Lockefeer on April 2, 1951, that on January 28, 1952, a decree of final distribution was made distributing all of the estate of C. J. Lockefeer to Mrs. Viola Lockefoer, that the petroleum irrogular route carrier service in question has been discontinued for a substantial period of time without any authorization to suspend or discontinue such operations, and that Mrs. Viola Lockefoer has requested this Commission to revoke such petroleum irregular route carrier operative rights; therefore, it is found that Mrs. Viola Lockefeer, the person entitled to request authority from this Commission to succood to C. J. Lockefeer's petroleum irrogular route carrier operativo rights, is no longer conducting and has abandoned said potroleum irrogular route carrier operation.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate issued to C. J. Lockefeer by Decision No. 44244 in this proceeding is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file in the name of C. J. Lockefeer are hereby cancelled.

The Secretary is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Mrs. Viola Lockefeer.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth (20th) day after service of a copy hereof upon Mrs. Viola Lockefeer, unless said Mrs. Viola Lockefeer before such effective date shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will thereby be stayed until hearing is held and further order issued.
