ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

It appearing by Commission Decision No. ~~44244~~, dated May 26, 1950; in the above proceeding, that C. J. Lockefer was authorized to establish and operate a service as a petroleum irregular route carrier for the transportation of petroleum and petroleum products in tank trucks and tank trailers between all points and places in the State of California, that C. J. Lockefer died March 17, 1951, that Mrs. Viola Lockefer was appointed administratrix of the estate of C. J. Lockefer on April 2, 1951, that on January 28, 1952, a decree of final distribution was made distributing all of the estate of C. J. Lockefer to Mrs. Viola Lockefer, that the petroleum irregular route carrier service in question has been discontinued for a substantial period of time without any authorization to suspend or discontinue such operations, and that Mrs. Viola Lockefer has requested this Commission to revoke such petroleum irregular route carrier operative rights; therefore, it is found that Mrs. Viola Lockefer, the person entitled to request authority from this Commission to succeed to C. J. Lockefer's petroleum irregular route carrier operative rights, is no longer conducting and has abandoned said petroleum irregular route carrier operation.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate issued to C. J. Lockefer by Decision No. ~~44244~~ in this proceeding is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file in the name of C. J. Lockefer are hereby cancelled.

The Secretary is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Mrs. Viola Lockfeer.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth (20th) day after service of a copy hereof upon Mrs. Viola Lockfeer, unless said Mrs. Viola Lockfeer before such effective date shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will thereby be stayed until hearing is held and further order issued.
