ORDER AMENDING DECISION

Applicant Victorville-Barstow Truck Line, a corporation, having filed a petition for a reconsideration of Decision No. 47805 herein and for an amendment thereof for the purpose of authorizing the transportation of dangerous explosives, upon reconsideration of said decision the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity require the inclusion of dangerous explosives among the general commodities which applicant shall be authorized by said decision to transport.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the following matter, to-wit, "g. Dangerous explosives" be and it is hereby deleted from the exceptions set forth in the ordering paragraph numbered "(1)" in said Decision No. 47805.
