SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 47590, dated August 19, 1952, the Commission exempted from the provisions of its competitive bidding rule the issue and sale by Sierra Pacific Power Company of \$1,500,000 in principal amount of a new series of first mortgage bonds provided that applicant receive for such bonds a price satisfactory to the Commission, the authorization so granted to terminate 90 days after the effective date of the order, or on November 18, 1952.

In its second supplemental application filed in this matter on November 3, 1952, applicant advises that it is negotiating with four institutions for the sale of its bonds, but that insufficient time remains within which to consummate the issue and sale of said bonds by November 18, 1952, and it requests the Commission to make an order extending the termination date set forth in the order in Decision No. 47590.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that applicant's request should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that paragraph 3 of Decision No. 47590, dated August 19, 1952, which now reads:

"This order is effective upon the date hereof. The authorization granted shall terminate ninety (90) days after the date of the order."


"This order is effective upon the date hereof. The authorization granted shall terminate on December 31, 1952."



IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that this second supplemental order is effective upon the date hereof.
