OPINION

Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company in this proceeding asks for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to exercise the rights and privileges of a franchise granted by the City of Los Banos, permitting the installation, maintenance, and use of a gas distribution and transmission system in the streets of said city. A public hearing was held before Examiner Daly on October 30, 1952 at San Francisco.

The franchise referred to, a copy of which is attached to the application and designated as Exhibit "B", was granted by the city in accordance with the Franchise Act of 1937, and is of indeterminate duration. A fee is payable annually to the City equivalent to 2% of the gross receipts arising from the use, operation, or possession of the franchise, but not less than 1% of the gross annual receipts from sales of gas within the limits of the city under said franchise.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity be and is granted to Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company to exercise the rights and privileges granted by the City of Los Banos by Ordinance No. 207 adopted July 16, 1952.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
