BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of the County of Fresno, State of California, for permission to construct and maintain a public highway at grade across the right of way and track of the West Side Branch of the Southern Pacific Railroad, at its intersection with Goldenrod Avenue between California Avenue and Howard Avenue in Fresno County, California.)

O R D E R

County of Fresno is authorized to construct Goldenrod Avenue at grade across the West Side San Joaquin Valley Line of Southern Pacific Company near Kernan, Fresno County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. BR-193.9. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than four per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1-A crossing signs (G.O.No.75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. Applicant alleges that due to the cotton harvest the crossing is needed at this time and requests that the order become effective as soon as possible. Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
