FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 46299, dated October 15, 1951, the Commission authorized Sunland-Tujunga Telephone Company to issue and sell \$150,000 par value of common stock on or before April 1, 1953, for the purpose of financing the cost of additions and improvements to its telephone plant and properties.

In a petition for extension of time filed in this proceeding on November 17, 1952, applicant reports that it has issued \$100,000 of the stock authorized by the Commission and that it originally had contemplated issuing the remaining \$50,000 of stock in the first quarter of 1953, but that deliveries of central office equipment and aerial cable have been delayed and consequently applicant's requirement for financing has been deferred. Accordingly, it requests the Commission to extend its authorization so as to permit it to sell the remaining stock at a time subsequent to April 1, 1953.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that applicant's request should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 46299, dated October 15, 1951, hereby is amended so as to permit

Sunland-Tujunga Telephone Company to issue and sell the stock authorized by said decision on or before August 1, 1953.

This first supplemental order will become effective upon the date hereof.
