ORDER

County of San Mateo is authorized to construct Fordham Street and Pomona Avenue at grade across Ravenswood spur track of Southern Pacific Company in the University Village Subdivision #3, San Mateo County, at the locations described in the application to be identified as Crossings Nos. DAB-30.6-C and DAB-30.9-C respectively. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossings and grades of approach shall be substantially as shown on Exhibits A and C attached to this application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by 2 Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G. O. No. 75-B).

The application also requested authority to construct a third crossing over the same spur at Santa Clara Avenue. There does not appear to be a clear need for such a crossing at the present time. Therefore, the request for authority to construct a crossing at Santa Clara Avenue will be denied without prejudice. The applicant has stated that such a course of action is satisfactory.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
