O R D E R

The City of Sacramento, Sacramento County, is authorized to construct a pedestrian crossing at grade across the main track of Central California Traction Company near 71st Street in that city, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 61-45.1-D. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Central California Traction Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not greater than 6 feet and grades of approach not greater than 6 per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 1 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by 1 Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G..O. No. 75-B) A turnstile shall be installed and maintained at expense of applicant, at the right-of-way fence on each side of the crossing.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This crossing is required to serve a recently constructed school which is now in session. Therefore the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
