O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a temporary industrial spur track at grade across Washington Street in the City of Placerville, El Dorado County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. AH-149.9-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and and with grades of approach substantially as shown on Sacramento Division Drawing No. S-1255, Revised November 10, 1952. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1-A crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Applicant alleges that said spur track is needed to serve industry until such time as permanent trackage described in Application No. 33841 of the State of California Department of Public Works has been installed. This temporary spur track crossing (AH-149.9-C) shall be removed at that time.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization

may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The temporary spur is required in connection with the relocation of the State Highway through Placerville now in progress, and applicant requests that this authority be made effective as of its date.

Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
