In the matter of application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of industrial spur track across Thomas Avenue in the City and County of San Francisco, State of California.

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Thomas Avenue in San Francisco County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. E-4.76-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach conforming substantially with official street grades. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The industry to be served requires early construction of the spur track and for this reason the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
