OPINION AND ORDER

Santa Paula Water Works, Ltd., a corporation, asks the Commission for authority to carry out the terms of an agreement, dated November 25, 1952, with Glen Anlauf and Winifred Anlauf, his wife, permitting them to take not to exceed 65,340 cubic feet of water per year, but not in excess of 179 cubic feet of water in any 24-hour period, of surface flow of Santa Paula Creek for garden purposes. The price to be paid for the right to take water is \$36.25 per year. The agreement will expire December 31, 1953.

A prior agreement, identical except for executed and expiration dates, was approved by the Commission in its Decision No. 46605, dated January 3, 1952.

The agreement does not, however, contain a clause providing that it be subject at all times to change or modification by this Commission in the exercise of its jurisdiction as is required by General Order No. 96. Appropriate revision of the agreement will be ordered.

The Commission having considered the request of the company and being of the opinion that the application should be granted and that a public hearing is not necessary, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Santa Paula Water Works, Ltd., a corporation, be authorized to carry out the terms and conditions of the agreement with Clen Anlauf and Winifred Anlauf, his wife, dated November 25, 1952, as set forth in Exhibit A attached to the application, which exhibit is made a part of this order by reference, upon revision of said agreement to include substantially the following provision:

> "This contract shall at all times be subject to such changes or modifications by the California Public Utilities Commission as said Commission may, from time to time, direct in the exercise of its jurisdiction."

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that:

- Applicant shall file with the Commission within thirty (30) days after the effective date of this order, two certified copies of the agreement as hereinabove ordered revised, together with a statement of the date on which the revised agreement is deemed to have become effective.
- 2. Applicant shall notify this Commission of the date of termination of said revised contract within thirty (30) days from and after said date of termination.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20)
