<u>O P I N I O N</u>

W. W. Miles, Pat L. Nolet and Ken D. Anderson, copartners, request authority to transfer their right to operate as a highway common carrier, granted pursuant to the provisions of Decision No. 47105, dated May 5, 1952, in Application No. 30262, together with certain equipment, to W. W. Miles and Pat L. Nolet, copartners.

Applicants allege that no purchase price is involved, that -Ken D. Anderson has not contributed his share of the capital requirements of the partnership and is not desirous of so doing in the future, and that the surviving partners will assume all obligations and hold the retiring partner harmless as to all liabilities of the partnership.

We find that the public interest will not be adversely affected by approval of the transfer of the operative right and equipment here involved. The application will be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

<u>ORDER</u>

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An application having been filed and the Commission being of the opinion that the authority requested should be granted,

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IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That W. W. Miles, Pat L. Nolet and Ken D. Anderson, after the effective date hereof and on or before March 6, 1953, may transfer the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted them by Decision No. 47105 dated May 5, 1952, together with the equipment referred to herein, to W. W. Miles and Pat L. Nolet, such transfer to be made in accordance with the provisions therefor contained in the application.

(2) That within thirty (30) days after the execution thereof, W. W. Miles and Pat L. Nolet shall file with the Commission a true copy of the instrument of transfer executed pursuant to the authority herein granted.

(3) That within ninety (90) days after the effective date hereof, applicants shall file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, appropriate tariffs on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public.
