O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an additional side track at grade across Winton Avenue in Hayward, Alameda County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. D-20.6. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two existing Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (G.O. No. 75-B), controlled by circuits connected to the four tracks comprising the grade crossing. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety

so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
