SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 46917, dated April 1, 1952, as amended by Decision No. 47555, dated August 11, 1952, the Commission authorized Pacific Greyhound Lines to sell certain real property and improvements located in the City of Oakland to Eby Machinery Company, Inc. on or before December 31, 1952.

Pacific Greyhound Lines has been using the property for maintenance, repair and storage purposes and it had intended to transfer these activities to a central plant it has been constructing in San Francisco. In its second supplemental application filed on January 6, 1953, it advises that completion of the new garage premises was delayed beyond expectation and it was impossible to consummate the transaction by December 31, 1952. It further advises that removal of its garage operations from the property proposed to be transferred has now been fully completed and the transaction is therefore ready for consummation. Accordingly, it requests a thirty-day extension of the time allowed in which to consummate the transaction.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion it should be granted; therefore,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time within which Pacific Greyhound Lines may sell the real property and improvements as authorized by Decision No. 46917, dated April 1, 1952, as amended, be, and it hereby is, extended to and including January 31, 1953.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that this second supplemental order is effective upon the date hereof.



