OPINION

United Transfer Company - Carley & Hamilton, Inc., requests that Decision No. 48008 dated December 2, 1952, in Application No. 32505 filed June 21, 1951, be amended to set forth the correct

name of said corporation instead of the name of United Transfer Company, a former corporation now merged with Carley & Hamilton, Inc., under the name of United Transfer Company - Carley & Hamilton, Inc. This merger and change of name was authorized by Decision No. 46425 dated November 20, 1951, in Application No. 32865 filed November 2, 1951.

J. M. Atthowe and C. H. Atthowe, copartners doing business under the firm name of East Bay Drayage & Warehouse Company, request that Decision No. 48008 dated December 2, 1952, in Application No. 32508 filed June 21, 1951, be amended to set forth their names as the holder of the certificate issued to J. M. Atthowe doing business as East Bay Drayage & Warehouse Company.

The application alleges that on January 18, 1952, J. M. Atthows filed his Application No. 33060 requesting authority to transfer his property and certificates of public convenience and necessity to himself and C. H. Atthows as copartners doing business as East Bay Drayage & Warehouse Company, which application for transfer was granted by this Commission on February 13, 1952, by Decision No. 46744. The present petition for modification further alleges that it was contemplated and intended by Application No. 33060 that all operative rights issued or to be issued should be operated by the partnership.

The Commission finds that said Decision No. 48008 should be emended so as to correctly state the names of said applicants. Consequently, the petition of United Transfor Company - Carley & Hamilton, Inc. and that of J. M. Atthowe and C. H. Atthowe will be granted. A public hearing is unnecessary.
