ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This is an application of Mt. Lassen Motor Transit, Inc., to transfer and Harold A. Stoy and Orville T. Stoy partners, doing business as Feather River Stages, to acquire certain operative rights and for authority of Mt. Lassen Motor Transit, Inc., to discontinue certain operations. The application was filed September 20, 1951. Because of the nature of the proceeding a public hearing would be required.

Since the filing of said application Feather River Stages has entered into an arrangement to sell its operations between Reno and Quincy to Pacific Greyhound Lines. However, Orville T. Stoy one of the copartners has represented himself as still desiring to acquire the operative rights of Mt. Lassen Motor Transit, Inc.; which are involved in the above-entitled proceeding.

It appears that the applicants have not been able to reach a conclusion as to what their wishes may be in the matter and whether they propose to proceed with the application. On September 20, 1951, the Commission wrote to applicants' counsel for information regarding the desire of applicants with reference to the matter. There was no response to this communication.

On December 12th the Commission again wrote to applicants' attorney to the effect that the matter would be summarily dismissed

if no reply was received by January 6, 1953. The files of the Commission do not show that any reply was made to this communication, nor was the letter even acknowledged.

In view of all the circumstances, and good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the above-entitled proceeding be and it hereby is dismissed.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
