
OPINION AND OFDER

John F. Nolan and Carl O. Simon, doing business as Ocean Shore Bus Line, are engaged in business as a passenger stage carrier between Sharp Park and Edgemar, on the one hand, and the intersection of Junipero Serra Boulevard and Portola Drive in the City and County of San Francisco, on the other hand. In this application they seek the Commission's approval of a certificate of insurance issued by Cravens, Dargan and Company providing for coverage by Lloyd's of London for personal bodily injury and for property damage as required by the provisions of the Commission's General Order No. 101. The certificate provides for coverage up to \$15,000 and \$80,000 for bodily injuries and up to \$10,000 for property damage.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted; therefore,

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IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:



1. The Commission hereby approves the certificate of insurance issued by Cravens, Dargan and Company providing for insurance coverage for John F. Nolan and Carl O. Simon, doing business as Ocean Shore Bus Line, by Lloyd's of London, together with a renewal, or renewals, of said certificates.

2. This order is effective upon the date hereof.
