OPINION AND ORDER

Gurnee Munn, Jr., doing business as Bantry Enterprises, is a passenger stage carrier operating between points in the San Fernando Valley, on the one hand, and the Santa Anita and Hollywood Park Race Tracks, on the other hand. In this application he seeks the Commission's approval of certificates of insurance issued by Cravens, Dargan and Company providing for coverage by Lloyd's of London for personal bodily injury and for property damage as required by the provisions of the Commission's General Order No. 101. The certificates provide for coverage up to \$50,000 and \$100,000 for bodily injuries and up to \$10,000 for property damage.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

l. The Commission hereby approves the certificates of insurance issued by Cravens, Dargan and Company providing for

insurance coverage for Gurnee Munn, Jr., doing business as Bantry. Enterprises, by Lloyd's of London, together with a renewal, or renewals, of said certificates.
