O R D E R

The City of South Gate is authorized to construct San Juan Avenue at grade across the Santa Ana Branch of Southern Pacific Company in the City of South Gate, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BK-491.0. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 30 feet and grades of approach not greater than six per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
