

## Decision No. 48261

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for authority to abandon its Class "E" non-agency station of CALVADA, in the County of Sierra, State of California, to eliminate the station reference of CALVADA from Timetable and other records and to cancel all tariffs to and from said CALVADA Station.

## QRDER

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company, filed on January 3, 1953 discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Calvada during the past two years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good cause appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Calvada, County of Sierra; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
