SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

In Decision No. 48269, entered today in these proceedings, the Commission found that City Carriers' Tariff No. 2-A - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A, should be amended by the addition of rates, rules and regulations for delivery of parcels, weighing 70 pounds or less, from manufacturers, manufacturers' agents, wholesalers, jobbers and commercial distributors. The tariff will be amended accordingly.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that City Carriers' Tariff No. 2-A - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A (Appendix "A" of Decisions Nos. 41362 and 41363, as amended, in Cases Nos. 4108 and 4109) be and it is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective March 15, 1953, Second Revised Page 6 cancels First Revised Page 6 and Fourth Revised Page 40 cancels Third Revised

Page 40, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof; and that tariff publications of common carrier respondents in Case No. 4109, filed as a result of this order may be made effective not earlier than March 15, 1953, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public if made effective on that date. In all other respects said Decisions Nos. 41362 and 41363, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that, except to the extent provided by the order herein, the petition filed by United Parcel Service of Los Angeles, Inc., on September 23, 1952, as amended, be and it is hereby denied, and that the petition filed by the Draymen's Association of Alameda County on December 9, 1952, be and it is hereby dismissed.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
