OPINION _AND ORDER

James W. Wootten, doing business as Charter Transit
Company, is engaged in business as a passenger stage carrier
between Stockton and Venice Island Ferry, and intermediate
points, and between Stockton and Bacon Island Ferry, and intermediate points. In this application he seeks the Commission's
approval of a certificate of insurance issued by Cravens, Dargan
& Company providing for coverage by Lloyd's of London for personal bodily injury and for property damage as required by the
provisions of the Commission's General Order No. 101. The
certificate provides for coverage up to \$50,000 and \$100,000 for
bodily injuries and up to \$10,000 for property damage.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The Commission hereby approves the certificate of insurance issued by Cravens, Dargan & Company providing for

insurance coverage for James W. Wootten, doing business as Charter Transit Company, by Lloyd's of London, together with a renewal, or renewals, of said certificate.

2. This order is effective upon the date hereof.
