OPINION AND ORDER

Jasper Bird and Maude B. Bird, applicants in this proceeding, are engaged in operating a public utility water distribution system in Grenada, Siskiyou County. In this application they seek authorization to abandon certain properties described as follows:

- (a) Beginning at a point South 0° 10' West, 630 feet from the 1/4 Section corner common to Sections 21 and 22 in Township 44 North, Range 6 West, Mount Diablo Meridian; thence South 0° 10' West, 100 feet; thence South 89° 50' East, 100 feet; thence North 0° 10' East, 100 feet; thence North 89° 50' West, 100 feet to the point of beginning.
- (b) A certain redwood 5" pipe water main running along the county road immediately parallel to the Julian Road and between the Townsite of Grenada and Highway No. 99.

According to the verified application, as amended, the parcel of land referred to in paragraph (a) is no longer used in the water operations, and the redwood water main referred to in paragraph (b) has been serving only two customers who have their own wells and who have signified their desire to discontinue applicants' service.

Based upon the representations made in this application, the Commission is of the opinion that the proposed transaction will not be adverse to the public interest and that an order should be entered granting the request, as herein provided; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. Jasper Bird and Maude B. Bird, on and after the effective date hereof, may sell and abandon the real property and the water main referred to herein. Applicants shall serve a copy of this decision on each customer attached to the water main herein authorized to be abandoned and shall furnish the Commission with proof of such service.

2. On or before April 30, 1953, applicants shall inform the Commission in writing of the action taken by them with respect to the authorization herein granted.

3. The authority herein granted will become effective twenty days after applicants have furnished copies of this decision to its customers as required in paragraph 1 of this order.
