SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Item No. 425-E of City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A provides a revised basis of minimum rates for wholesale parcel delivery service in San Francisco, effective March 15, 1953 (Decision No. 48269 of February 10, 1953). Through inadvertence the charges produced by these rates are subject to the surcharge in Supplement No. 4 to the tariff and they are not made applicable to deliveries from manufacturers. These inadvertences should be corrected before the item becomes effective.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 41363 as amended) be and it is hereby further amended by incorporating therein Supplement No. 5 cancels Supplement No. 4, and Ninth Revised Page 40 cancels Eighth Revised Page 40 and Seventh Revised Page 40, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

This order shall become effective March 15, 1953.

(1) APPLICATION OF SURCHARGE

*(a) Except as provided in paragraph (b) below, compute the amount of charges in accordance with the rates, rules and regulations of the tariff. Increase the amount so computed by sixteen (16) percent, except as to rates and charges provided in Item No. 570 series. Increase the amount computed under Item No. 570 series by four (4) percent. Fractions will be disposed of as provided in paragraph (c) below.

*(b) The provisions of paragraph (a) will not apply to rates and charges computed in accordance with Items Nos. 220, 222, 425 and 580 series.

(c) Fractions of less than one-half cent shall be dropped; fractions of one-half cent or greater shall be increased to one cent.
