
CALA, ORDER

The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade along and across Islais Creek Channel and Boutwell Street in the City of San Francisco, San Francisco County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 4L-3.75-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal cr superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails fluch with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. No crossing protection shall be required as the streets involved are unimproved. Upon improvement of the streets the railroad shall install protection in the form of one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advice the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant has advised that the construction of the warehouse of Kaemper, Barrett & Smoot, which this spur will serve, has been
