OPINION AND ORDER

Walter R. McCoy, doing business as McCoy's Limousine Service, is engaged in operating a passenger stage service for the transportation of nonscheduled airline passengers and their baggage from the Oakland Municipal Airport to certain specified hotels and depots in Oakland and San Francisco, and to Treasure Island.<sup>1/</sup> In this application he seeks the Commission's approval of a certificate of insurance issued by Watson Surplus Lines Agency, Inc. providing for coverage by Lloyd's of London for personal bodily injury and for property damage as required by the provisions of the Commission's General Order No. 101. The certificate provides for coverage in the amounts of \$15,000 and \$100,000 for bodily injuries and in the amount of \$10,000 for property damage.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted; therefore,
