ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

By application filed with this Commission October 30, 1952, Martin H. Richards, doing business as Richards Transportation Co. requests the revocation of the certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by Decision No. 44395 dated June 20, 1950 in Application No. 31222. As reason for such request, applicant alleges that he discontinued operations on or about June 5, 1950. All permits held by applicant were revoked July 6, 1950 because of the sale of his business and all equipment to Signal Trucking Service, Ltd. Said sale included his operative rights granted by Decision No. 43049 dated June 28, 1949 in Application No. 29629 but not the rights granted by said Decision No. 14395. His actual operation coincided with the rights sold and applicant has never served the public pursuant to any rights under the certificate herein sought to be revoked. Consequently the Commission finds that Martin H. Richards has not conducted and is not now conducting service as a petroleum irregular route carrier. A public hearing is unnecessary.

Application therefor having been filed and the Commission being fully advised in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Martin Richards doing business as Richards
