ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

It appearing by Decision No. 42683 dated April 5, 1949, in the above numbered application that Ray K. Parson was authorized to acquire and operate a service as a passenger stage corporation for the transportation of passengers and their baggage and of express between Santa Maria and Santa Maria Municipal Airport as granted to his predecessor T. E. Shamblin by Decision No. 41026, dated December 17, 1947 in Application No. 28915; and it further appearing that said Ray K. Parsons does not have on file adequate insurance protection against liability imposed by law for the payment of damages for personal injury or property damage as required by General Order No. 101; and that the passenger stage service in question was discontinued in December, 1952; therefore, it is found that Ray K. Parson is no longer conducting and has discontinued said passenger stage operation.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity acquired by Ray K. Parson pursuant to said Decision No. 42683 is hereby revoked and all effective timetables and tariffs on file in the name of Ray K. Parson are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon said Ray K. Parson.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after service of a copy hereof upon Ray K. Parson unless before such effective date he shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order, denying the facts set forth herein and

requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until hearing is had and further order issued.
